## General Information

### A. LEAVE TAKING

1. Granting of leave is only by previous written application from the parents or guardian. Failure to comply with this requirement will be condoned only in the case of an emergency.
2. After leave, when the student returns to the school, the page "Leave record" in the handbook must be filled in.
3. A student whose unauthorised absence is more than 10% of the school working days may not be allowed to sit for the examination.
4. A student who is absent for a month, without prior permission from the Principal will have his/her name struck off from the rolls. They may be re-admitted on paying the admission fee.
5. After any vacation every student should be present on the re-opening day of the school.

### B. EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

1. The pupil's progress is assessed by means of Formative Tests and Summative Tests at the end of which the progress report is issued (to keep the parents informed about the progress of their child).
2. Parents are expected to go through the report card, sign it and return it to the class teacher.
3. Students whose dues are not cleared completely will not be allowed to write the examinations.
4. To secure promotion one must obtain pass mark in all subjects and must have regularity in attendance. The marks of the Formative Tests and Summative Tests will be considered for promotion.
5. The decision taken by the school authority regarding promotion is final and shall not be reconsidered.

### **C. PRIVATE TUITIONS**

As a general rule the practice of private tuitions is not encouraged. In case where the child is extremely weak in a particular subject (s) the following procedure is strictly to be adhered to:

- i) Parents of such students should apply to the Principal, who will arrange for the pupil to be coached privately.
- ii) Parents are advised against entering into private arrangements with teachers in this regard.

### **D. WITHDRAWAL**

1. Transfer certificate will be issued when all the dues are cleared and on receipt of a written application from the parent/guardian only.
2. If the parent wants to withdraw his/her child, a written notice should be given to the principal in the month of January and fee has to be paid in lieu of the above.
3. The management reserves the right to compel the parents to withdraw their child if his/her progress is irregular or his/her conduct is harmful to other students.

### **E. DISMISSAL**

1. Irregular attendance, habitual disobedience and misconduct is injurious to the moral tone of the school and justifies dismissal at any time of the year.
2. Malpractice in an examination is a great offence and shall lead to detention and even dismissal.
3. In case of any misbehavior of a serious nature that has become public nuisance, the child is liable for suspension or dismissal even though it took place outside the school premises.
4. Students and Parents are required to conduct themselves in a proper manner and treat all teaching and non-teaching staff with respect at all times. Inappropriate behaviour by the pupil or the parent could result in dismissal.



## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Students are required to be in the school premises before am 8:20 am as the gate will be closed after this time.
2. All students are expected to come to school in neat, clean and complete uniform.
3. All students are required to speak only in English within the school premises.
4. It is the duty of every pupil to keep his/her classroom and the school premises absolutely clean. Scribbling on the wall, desks and damaging school property will be dealt with severely.
5. Students are responsible for the safe custody of their books and other belongings. The school is not responsible for the items lost.
6. All students are expected to take part in all co-curricular activities of the school, as these are part of the school curriculum.
7. Students will be allowed to leave the school premises during working hours with the permission of the Principal only.

## **FOR THE ATTENTION OF THE PARENTS / GUARDIAN**

1. Parents should take care of the personal hygiene of their children.
2. Parents are not permitted to meet the students or teachers during working hours, without the permission of the Principal. Parents should contact the Principal regarding any complaint and not the teachers directly.
3. If the child is not making desired progress, the Principal should be contacted early in the academic year for seeking out ways for the child's improvement.
4. Criticising any of the teachers or the school in the presence of the child should be avoided as this would discourage the child from learning.

5. Parents are responsible to ensure that their child completes the homework given to him/her and learns lessons taught in the class.
6. Parents should not indulge in any kind of group meetings and create nuisance of any kind in and around the school premises. Non-observance of the above rules will be regarded as a serious breach of discipline and the child's name will be removed from the rolls.
7. Though every care is taken to ensure the safety and welfare of the student, accidents are possible. The school will not be responsible for such accidents, small or serious, during the school hours.
8. Parents are requested to inform the Principal of any change of address or telephone number.
9. Parents are requested not to give any valuable things, eg. mobile, gold ornaments, gadgets etc., to their children. If any such things are found with children they will be confiscated.

## **BUS RULES**

- All the students using the school bus are expected to be on the right side of the bus.
- The bus drivers are authorized to stop buses at the designated stops. The list of stops is prepared, keeping in view the convenience and safety of all bus commuters and is subject to change.
- When the bus is in motion students must not move in the bus.
- Students will be held responsible for any damage to buses caused by negligence or vandalism.
- The driver's attention must not be distracted for any reason. The bus teachers, bus monitors and students are responsible for maintaining discipline in the buses. Any serious offence must be reported to Principal.

### **A WORD OF CAUTION**

Violation of any of the school regulations could result in the dismissal of the pupil concerned. If such a disciplinary action has to be taken, it will be useless on the part of the student or parent to plead ignorance of the rules as **EVERY STUDENT OR PARENT IS EXPECTED TO ACQUAINT HIMSELF/HERSELF WITH THE REGULATIONS OF SCHOOL AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION.**

### **LIBRARY**

The school library is a facility for the staff and students to enrich themselves through more information and knowledge. Students from classes V to X can enroll themselves as members on a payment of Rs. 50/- per academic year to the librarian during the first term. A library period is allotted for all the classes.

### **SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025**

The academic year is from June to May. Summer holidays will be from the 3rd week of April to 4th week of May.

### **SCHOOL DAYS AND WORKING HOURS**
